You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

In order to process your return we must disclose all of your 2013 tax return information to **DRAKE TAX SOFTWARE** that we partner with in order to provide certain services.
